# Concept Note

## Gandhi's Vision and its Resonance in Pre/Post Independence India

*Mahatma Gandhi, revered as 'The Father of the Nation' is not only remembered for his seminal role in Indian Independence; but also as a social reformer, an educationist, philosopher and economist. Despite his paramount contribution in the constitution of a secular, democratic nation state, his views/approaches often differed from the ideas of other visionaries and nationalist leaders like Rabindranath Tagore, Subhas Chandra Bose and Babasaheb Ambedkar; among a few others. The present socio-political and cultural milieu of the nation which has undergone much envisaged and contested changes in different sectors after the independence, and further corroborated/embroiled with the advent of 'globalization' raise some pivotal questions on the relevance of Gandhi's visions, considering the ever-dynamic nature of the post-independence context. Thus, the seminar aims at focusing on the present state that calls upon the irrefutable need to (re)locate/assess Gandhi's visions in the shifting trajectories and how/where they could be employed /remoulded for greater national interests.*
